

“Improving Health and Well-being with the help of OSNs”

iSocial Video Challenge
01 March - 15 May 2016



The iSocial Video Challenge provides **high school and first-year undergraduate students** in Europe with the opportunity to deliver a **2 minutes video** in YouTube where the theme is:

“Online Social Networks for Health and Well-being”

The participants are expected to propose a novel way (new features or services) of using Online Social Networks (OSNs) which would benefit the users or society at large. Teams of up to three students are eligible to participate, and videos will be judged by the iSocial consortium.

The videos will be evaluated taking into account the following questions:

- ◆ How well is the proposed idea conveyed in the video?
- ◆ How novel is the proposed idea?
- ◆ What are the benefits of the proposed idea and what functionality does it bring to OSNs?
- ◆ How realistic/feasible is to implement the proposed idea to current OSNs?
- ◆ The winners will be invited to present their idea at the summer school in Crete, Greece (**September 2016**). Their expenses (air tickets/accommodation) will be covered by the project.

Submissions are accepted online between **30 March and 15 May, 2016**.
